Description of my Academic Experience

My classmates and I visited an Institution for Young People as a project of the Public Health course in order to promote food education. I also remember that in this course I learned about how the different programs to fight anemia and vitamin deficiency were created in Brazil. Learning about the history of this country allowed me to acquire other knowledges.

In the Epidemiology course I learned how to interpret epidemiological tables and perform math's operations with the objective to get the proportion, ratio, rate, etc. In addition, we had a presentation where we showed the population statistics of a specific city in Brazil, this way, we could learn about the reality of this city.

I really liked the Physical Activity course, thought in separate groups, because it included very important topics, such as Diabetes, High Blood Pressure and Obesity which are common diseases in our days and each physical activity will be recommended depending on the age phase, pathology and genetics of the person. The Biochemistry course at UNIFÉ was useful to understand this issues related to biochemistry. During the course, professor Young-Bum Kim (Harvard – USA) had an interesting presentation about the Fight to Obesity and Diabetes which supported what I had learned in class.

As an extracurricular activity, I could attend a conference about Diabetes in Sao Paulo which only focused on issues related to the Diabetes Mellitus in the different age phases of life. It was carried out by Nutritionist and Doctors of the Sao Paulo University (USP).

The Academic Program of Education Mobility

PAME

Offer of posts – Period 2015 – 2016

Description:

The mobility in these categories implies to stay in a university for an academic period, with a full recognition of the performed activities in the home university.

Types of Scholarships

Total Coverage Posts. - the host university covers the accommodation and nourishment fees of the student as well as the exemption from all the academic fees.

Partial Coverage Posts. - the host university will only provide the student with the exemption of the academic fees.

Mobility Categories and Options

- A. Technical level, Bachelor's degree and Postgraduate students.
- B. Professors and researchers.
- C. Graduates and recently qualified professionals, no more than one year to have been graduated or qualified professionals from a career of technical level or Bachelor's degree. (This category does not include Postgraduates)
- D. Mentors or consultants (professors or researchers)

To apply for a scholarship, you should contact the International Co-operation Office of your university and the Focal Point of the selected country in order to request your COVER LETTER for the host university. Your institution is going to pre-select the applicants and to present the APPLICATIONS to PRONABEC, the Peru's Focal Point. The Pre-Selection and Selection Committee of Applicants – PRONABEC, after validation and evaluation, will present the OFICIAL APPLICATIONS to Focal Points of Chile – AGCI, Colombia – ICETEX and Mexico – AMEXCID who will provide you a scholarship after evaluation of the requirements you must qualify.
